Ryman League Division 1 South side Corinthian-Casuals are excited to announce the establishment of the new Glenthorne Sixth Form Academy football development programme in collaboration with Glenthorne High School, Sutton.

Budding footballers are being offered the opportunity to pull on the famous chocolate and pink jersey and represent one of the UK's landmark football clubs while studying for their A Levels on a specially tailored study programme at a school boasting excellent pass rates and facilities.

The Academy will compete in the Youth Alliance League as Corinthian-Casuals and the English Colleges League as Glenthorne High School, and will enter a number of nationwide and local cup competitions.

Home games for the Corinthian-Casuals Academy team will be played at the club's King George's Field ground in Tolworth.

Matches will take place on Wednesday afternoons. Training sessions will be held three times per week led by coaches holding a minimum UEFA B coaching licence, and include an analytical element to teach students the theory and strategy of the game.

Students will also be given the opportunity to pass the FA Level One Coaching Award and Referee Certificate.
